

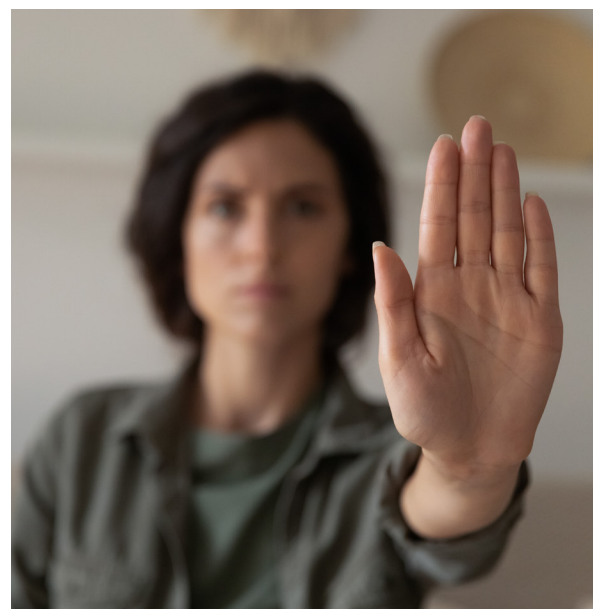
Social Initiatives: Community Partnerships

Domestic Violence Prevention DOVE 2016

DOVE, founded in 1978 as a crisis hotline, has expanded to a multi-service organization, providing comprehensive direct services and support for victims of dating, domestic violence and their children. They work with adults, teens, and children abused financially, emotionally, physically, and sexually. In addition, Photon helps DOVE regularly by providing outreach and conducting educational presentations about domestic violence to civic and community groups, churches, and faith-based organizations; schools, colleges, and universities; and others.





American Heart Association Heart Walk 2016

The American Heart Association is the nation's oldest and largest voluntary organization for fighting heart disease and stroke. American Heart Association funds innovative research, fight for more robust public health policies. It provides critical tools and information to save and improve lives and provides public health education in various ways. For example, it is the nation's leader in CPR education training. Bright Pink - Breast & Ovarian Cancer Awareness 2016
